## **Certificate of Higher Education in Theology, Ministry and Mission (120 credits)**

This programme is available at **ERMC** in part-time and full-time mode of study.

All modules are delivered in-person, at teaching centres (not all modules are available at all centres) and online with the following exceptions:

TMM1067, TMM1087, TMM1191, TMM1717, TMM1397, TMM1707, TMM1737 are delivered solely online

TMM1207, TMM1267, TMM1447, TMM1451 are delivered solely in person at residential events.

TMM1347, TMM1537 are delivered in person at residential events, in person at relevant teaching centres and online

Students will negotiate their choice of modules with the Director of Studies according to module availability in any year of study in light of the ministry for which they are preparing or already serve. Certain combinations of modules are excluded, as detailed in the module descriptors.

Modules which appear in more than one list may only be studied once.
