Diploma of Higher Education in Theology, Ministry and Mission (240 credits)

 This programme is available at Luther King Centre in full-time and part-time modes of study. Students are expected to agree their modules choices with their College Principal, and this will reflect any past study and experience together with particular requirements for the patterns of ministry and service anticipated in the future.

LKC offers certain modules on a rotating basis dependent on demand. Full details of those available for study are provided at the beginning of each academic year. Certain combinations of modules are excluded or are co-requisites, as detailed in the module descriptors. A module may appear in more than one list but may only be taken once.
