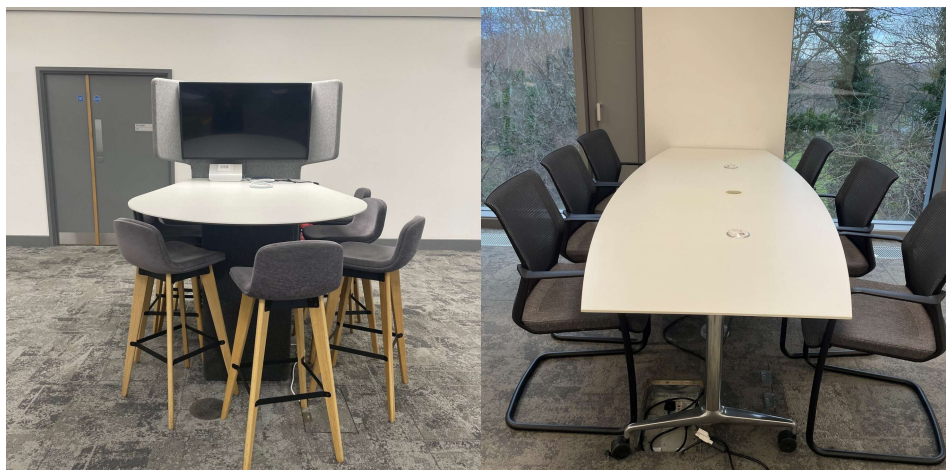
The TLC is the ideal location for our events with a cafe, ample teaching rooms and space for our students to study.

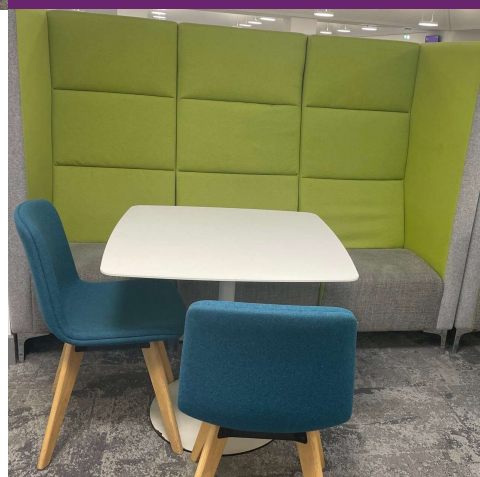
